

## Minutes of Meeting

2. To plan anti-ragging measures in the upcoming session (2025-26)
3. Any other agenda with the permission of the Chair

Minutes of meeting:

Chairman Anti ragging committee asked the Chief Proctor to brief about the measures taken by the Anti-ragging committee. The following points were briefed:

1. Not a single case of ragging was reported in the campus in the session 2025-26.
2. Installation of CCTV cameras in lecture halls and laboratories has been completed.
3. Anti-ragging warnings are published in prospectus and college website.
4. Warnings are displayed in academic blocks and hostels.
5. Anti-ragging squads were formed for hostels.
6. Surprise visits conducted by authorities.
7. Awareness programs conducted during orientation.
8. Random surprise visits in common areas like canteen, lawns, etc.
9. Revised procedure for online undertaking implemented via [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in).

Note: Chairman suggested dividing institute into zones for monitoring.

The Chairman appreciated the efforts of the Anti-ragging committee and maintaining a ragging-free campus.
